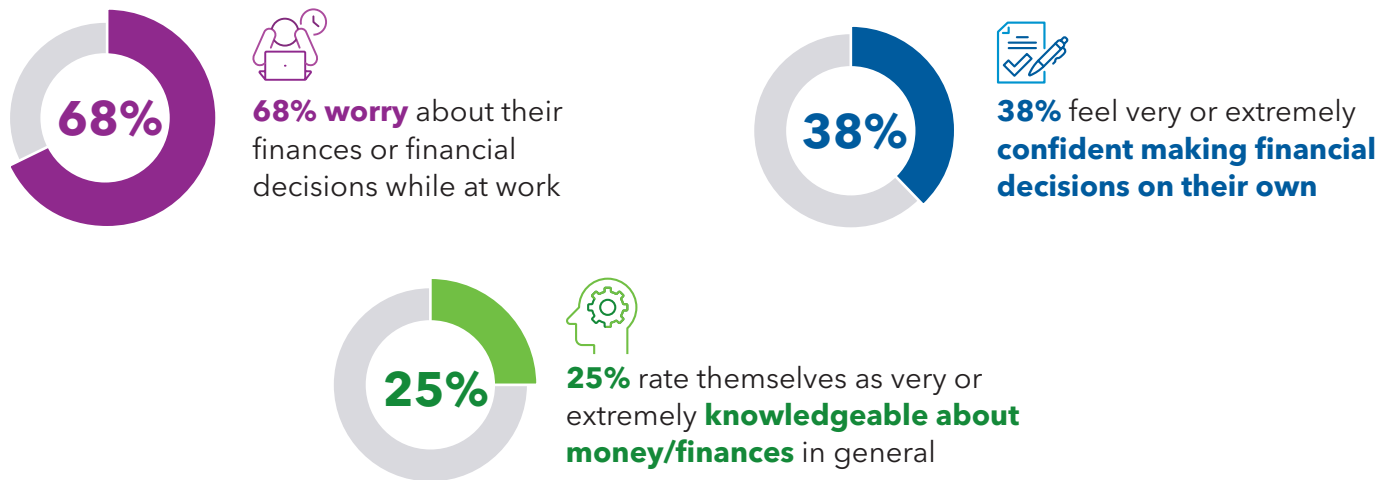


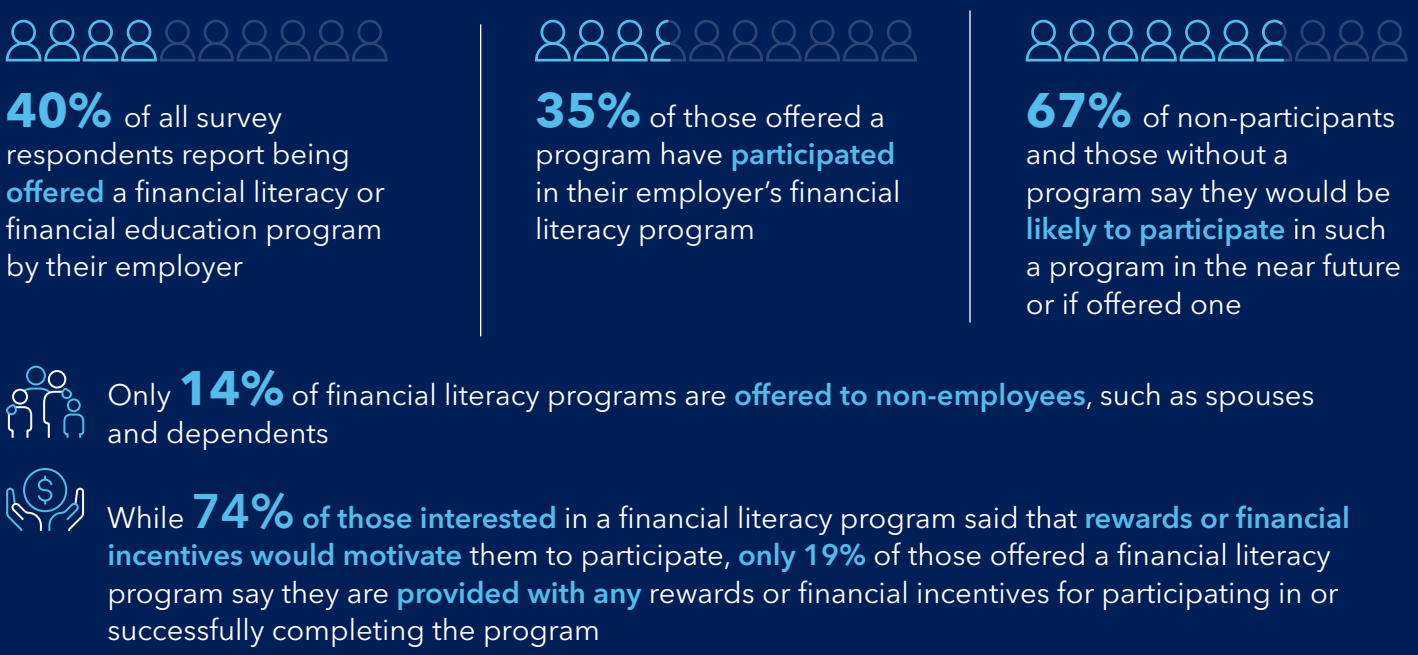
Financial Literacy Programs: What Do Public Sector Workers Want and Need?

Participants shared their preferences on financial literacy program topics and formats, as well the topics and formats their employer most commonly offers.

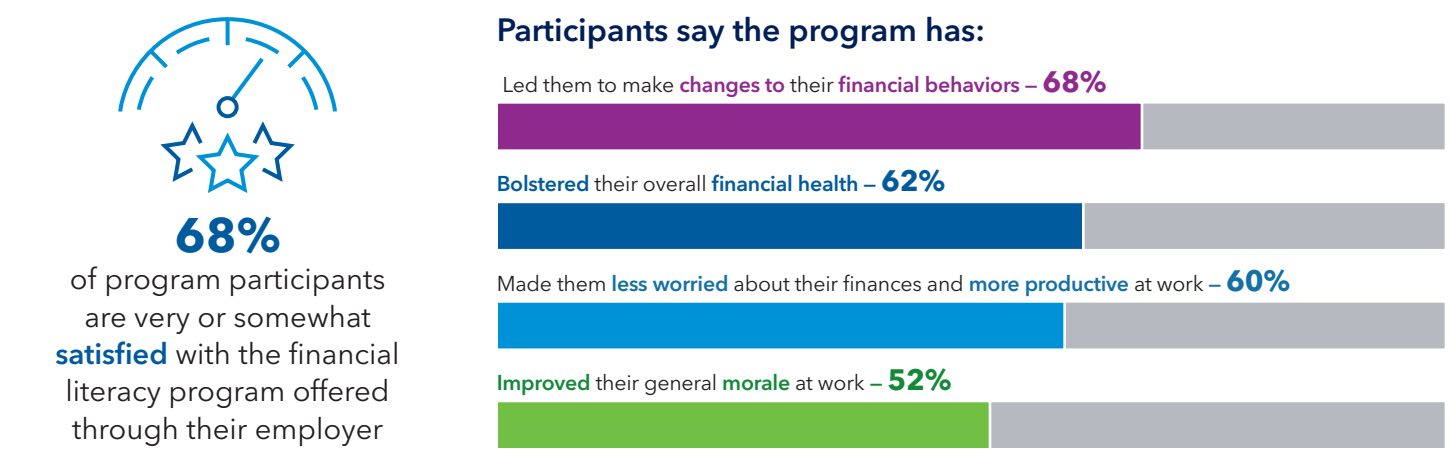

Public sector workers believe their employer plays a critical role in improving their financial health:



In November 2022, MissionSquare Research Institute conducted an online survey of 1,002 state and local government employees, fielded by Greenwald Research, to assess employee worries about finances; employer-provided financial literacy program prevalence and participation; program topics, communication, administration and tailoring; program satisfaction, communication and evaluation; and respondents' financial profiles.
